Are You a UK Taxpayer? If so you can help Reach!

- If you are a UK taxpayer you can increase the value of your donation by 28p for every £1 you give and at no extra cost to yourself. You need to be paying income tax or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that Reach will reclaim. You are not required to declare such payments on your income tax return.
- If you are a higher rate tax payer you can claim tax relief for your payments (please ask Sue for a receipt)
- Reach will benefit tremendously if you use this form, so please fill it in and post it at the soonest opportunity. This declaration entitles us to reclaim money that would otherwise be kept by the Inland Revenue, and is applicable to membership payments as well as one-off donations.

If you wish to you can register once and will not need to repeat the procedure for future donations.
